



2015 International 6 Metre World Championship **Harbour Measures**

General Information:

Measures relative to 6mR World Championship boats with respect to parking, handling and launching requirements will be valid during the following periods:

- Parking for trucks and trailers, land storage of 6mR World Championship boats:
Free from May 20th to June 14th 2015
- Spaces on the water for registered boats:
Free from May 23rd to June 9th 2015

Requests for spaces not covered by the above dates will be handled directly by the Trinité sur Mer Harbour Office; fees will be charged by the Harbour in such case.

Costs of Handling:

A special price for handling requirements has been set at 200 Euros all-in for; it covers :

- One handling and launching manoeuvre (crane or travel lift)
- One handling and hoisting manoeuvre (crane or travel lift)
- Mast stepping and mast unstepping (crane)
Participants are requested to preferably have mast stepping on trailer or truck at parking space and mast unstepping before lifting out
- If required, launching of RIB (tenders slipway to be used - see attached map)
- Trucks & trailer parking space –(see attached map)

Opening Hours:

Launching manoeuvres: 9:00 to 12:30 and 14:00 to 18:00 (**all days except Monday and Sunday; however lifting out will be possible on Monday June 8th**)

Slots - Pontoons:

Reserved spaces will be available for 6mr World Championship boats from May 23rd to June 9th 2015 at the **MOLE CARADEC** (see attached map).

Harbour will indicate to RIB's owners space available for RIB

Above pontoons indications may be modified in the event of adverse weather conditions

Other Boats

The arrival of accompanying boats (yachts, trawler, etc.) should be notified in advance to The Trinité sur Mer Harbour Office; it will do its best to ensure possible installation near the 6mR pontoon

Tugging needs : Harbour may be contacted on channel 9

Mandatory Information to be Provided Upon Registration

All participants are requested to return to Pierre-Yves Le Guen (in charge for SNT of all logistics issues) duly filled in the form he will send them by email to get all details regarding dates of arrivals, liftings, parking space needs..... (see attached form).

Information provided in this form will be transferred to the Harbour Office by SNT.

Cost of handling will be settled upon registration. A hoisting and handling voucher will be available at SNT's office (please indicate if you prefer receiving it by email).

Please note each owner (or his designated representative) of every boat **must**:

- Nominate a contact (skipper, owner, or other) **whose presence is mandatory on the day of launching and mast stepping as well as on the day of mast unstepping and hoisting** (Name – Cell phone N° – email address)
- Provide boat's date of arrival indicating whether it's by land or by sea (estimated date if by sea) & planned date of boat's departure
- Provide spare keys of trucks parked on spaces managed by the Harbour Office for the duration of the World Championship: keys to be dropped off at the Harbor Office (in the event of major problems – fire, accident, etc.).

Following registration of the boat on SNT's website, each owner is responsible for making an appointment, by email or by telephone, with the Harbour Office with respect to launching requirements.

NB: In the event that World Championship results are validated on the evening of Thursday June 4th, or before noon on Friday, June 5th, it will possible to begin hoisting manoeuvres on Friday afternoon.
